The Diplomacy Center Foundation is the private-sector partner to the US Department of State in creating the National Museum of American Diplomacy (NMAD)—the first museum dedicated to telling the history, practice, and challenges of American diplomacy. We support NMAD through generous donations made by individuals, foundations, and corporations.

Our Vision

We seek to share stories of American diplomacy, honor the contributions of the American diplomatic community, and preserve the legacy of American diplomacy for generations to come.

Founding and History

The Diplomacy Center Foundation was founded in 2000 as the Foreign Affairs Museum Council by Ambassador Stephen Low (1927 - 2010) and Senator Charles McC. Mathias (1922-2010). They created the Council with the purpose to build the first museum dedicated to American diplomacy.

Low and Mathias gained the support of then-US Secretary of State Madeleine K. Albright for the museum to be located at the Department of State. In 2013, the FAMC Board of Directors changed its name to the Diplomacy Center Foundation. In 2017, the construction of the museum pavilion was completed, and the Diplomacy Center Foundation continues to seek private sector funds to complete the new facility.
